



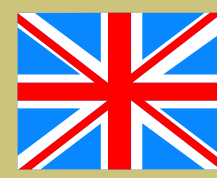
Puente Romano

Estación de FERROCARRIL



Construida a finales del siglo XIX, en la línea de ferrocarril de Bobadilla a Algeciras, todavía conserva una inigualable estampa romántica, junto a peculiares elementos de una época que se resisten a desaparecer, a pesar de las innovaciones ferroviarias sufridas hasta la fecha.

Desprende cierto aire arquitectónico anglosajón, pero sin perder el tipismo y colorido de Andalucía, que se hacía patente a través de sus frondosas y floridas jardineras o macetas.



RAILWAY STATION

The station was built at the end of the 19th century, on the Bobadilla-Algeciras rail line. Despite its present state of disrepair, it conserves its unique touch of romanticism and its own peculiar elements of an age which refuses to disappear even in the face of the railway innovations suffered to date.

It has a certain air of Anglo Saxon architecture, although its Andalusian style and colour, evident in its leafy gardens and potted plants, is never lost.
